

Serenity Group Service Positions

Per group conscience approval Oct 19, 2020 all positions will begin in January and be held for one year, with the exception of Treasurer and GSRs, who serve for two years. AA's "spirit of rotation" suggests trusted servants will leave positions open after serving for a period set by the group conscience. A Serenity home group member may serve in multiple positions over time, non-concurrently. It is suggested in the AA Service Manual that an AA member serves, and votes, in only one AA group, designated as their "home group".

All positions require a period of 6 months continuous sobriety, and regular attendance at monthly Serenity group conscience meetings, either in-person or online. Any further questions please email ginnymerc@gmail.com – welcome to all who want to be part of the service group at Serenity!

The only requirement is 6 months sobriety and an interest in service. Most positions call for very little time commitment but do include attendance at group conscience and willingness to participate. Service at your home group is a great way to feel connected and useful and helps strengthen the group overall. No position requires you to know everything or manage responsibilities alone – **we're in this together.**
